

The Advisory Team and Council are working on several important efforts behind the scenes in support of ministry at UNITY. This week, we will not be in front of the congregation, but we will continue the ongoing work needed to care for UNITY during this season of transition.

The Advisory Team has begun the process of searching for a Senior Interim/Lead Pastor. This will take time, and we ask for your continued prayers as we move through this important step with care and discernment. The Greater Milwaukee Synod has provided an initial candidate, and at the time of this writing, we hope to meet with this person in the next week.

We have also started interviewing candidates for the Director of Music Ministry position as we plan for Lynn Key's retirement in September. In addition, we will cast a wider net as we continue the search for a Director of Christian Education. UNITY has also created a LinkedIn page for members to join, giving us another way to stay connected and share updates.

Upcoming Council leadership meetings are being scheduled to discuss property needs over the next three to five years. We will also meet with Finance, Stewardship, and Servant Ministries leaders to better understand our budget and benevolence through the end of 2026 and beyond.

We continue to check in with our talented and gifted Pastors and Staff as they do important work on behalf of the congregation. UNITY is blessed by their care, energy, and leadership, and we encourage you to share your gratitude with them.

As UNITY continues to discern the path forward, we are stronger together. Please continue to stay involved, offer patience, and hold our Pastors, Staff, Advisory Team, Council, and congregation in prayer.
